## 1. Monthly Economic Update

The Partnership Unit produces a monthly economic update outlining the economic situation in the sub-region. The report uses a number of national statistics together with data collected from Local Authorities and other partners to give an overall picture of developments in the economy. The report is produced in two sections; the headline report which indicates key trends within each sector and a data file containing all the background data and long term trends. ## 2. Tracking Perceptions of Personal Finances

This report from Yorkshire Futures measures Yorkshire and Humber residents' perceptions of their personal finances in the current economic climate. The report shows that residents' perceptions have changed only marginally since the last report, with 60% of respondents still stating they are poorer financially than last year.

North Yorkshire County Council has drawn together an array of national statistics to paint a picture of life in the districts within North Yorkshire and the neighbourhoods within the districts.

These neighbourhood profiles contain information on topics such as:

- Age and ethnicity;
- Health;

- Education; and
- The local economy.

#### **4. Rural Services Data Series: Availability of Services Output Area Data 2009**

Service availability and accessibility is a key rural policy issue. In order to monitor changing levels of service availability, this report combines datasets that show where outlets of particular services can be found, with postcode level information on the distribution of households.
